



# LED Table Light

## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

### Safety Warnings

- This product is only suitable for connection to a 220-240V~50Hz supply in accordance with current IEE Wiring Regulations. It is for indoor use only, and not suitable for a bathroom location.
- If the lamp has a Class II, Double Insulated symbol  it does not require an Earth, and Live or Neutral **must not** be connected to Earth. If the lamp has a Class III symbol  it may use a plug-in transformer. Under no circumstances must this be replaced by a standard 13amp UK type plug. This will cause a safety hazard.
- If the mains cable becomes damaged it must only be replaced by a technically competent, qualified person. In the case of a Class III rated product, a new cable set may be available - please check with your retailer.
- Do not plug into the mains until your lamp is fully assembled.
- Under no circumstances must this table lamp be covered with any material as this could pose a safety hazard. It must be used on a stable, flat surface.
- This product contains non-replaceable LEDs. If the LEDs become damaged the whole unit must be replaced.
- If you are in any doubt about your competence please consult a qualified electrician.
- If any modification is made it will invalidate the warranty and may render the product unsafe.

### Care Information

Allow 10 minutes to cool before adjusting or cleaning.

Clean with a dry cloth only. Do not use liquid or abrasive cleaners on this product.

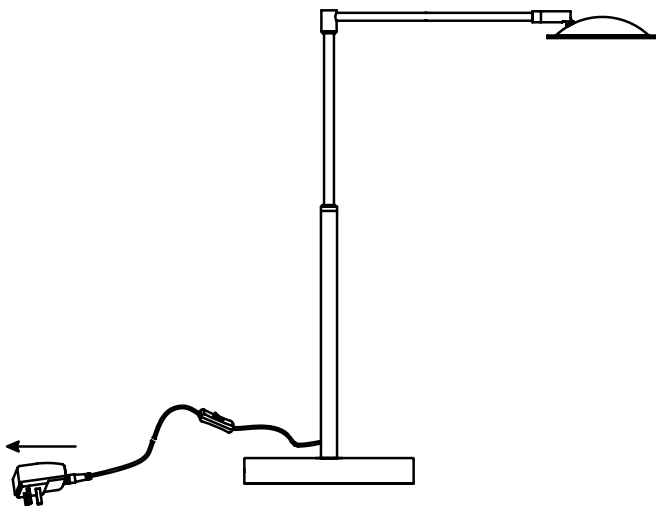
### Assembly/ User Instructions

#### Before you start

Please read these instructions carefully before fitting and retain for reference. Check the packaging and make sure that you have all the required parts. Follow each assembly step in order to prevent incorrect assembly. Ensure that the product is fully assembled before use.

**These assembly diagrams are intended as a guide – your individual product may vary from that below. If in doubt, please consult a qualified electrician.**

1. Carefully unpack your lamp, and place your lamp on a stable, flat surface.
2. In the case of a Class III product, the driver may need to be affixed to the product. Plug in the LED driver.
3. Operate the switch to turn on.
4. If the product has a movable head or arm, ensure you keep one hand on the base or stem while moving to provide stability.



If your lamp will not illuminate, please check the relevant fuse in your fuse box. If unsuccessful please consult your retailer.
